The Hotel is beautiful, just renovated during COVID. I looked at all the rooms that we would have for our events. In all cases, the rooms are bigger and better than the rooms of our previous Reunion in Jacksonville. I was particularly impressed with the space for our Banquet Dinner. It is best described as a "Ball Room" with beautiful giant glass chandeliers. I was given the option of selecting the rooms I was shown, I feel sure all of you will be pleased. The good news is they are included at no additional charge to us, including the Hospitality Room, which will easily support 60 People.

## **Crowne Plaza Hotel**

Check-in Time: 3:00 PM Check-out Time: 11:00 AM

Room Cost: Sunday through Thursday is \$139 and Friday through Saturday is \$159 (the average

of \$149 per night if you stayed the 4 days)

Our Reunion Room Rate is the Off-Season Rate even though during our event, it is the peak season for the Hotel. When you book rooms, use a YOS code, and have several ways to book rooms. **You can call (401) 732-6000 or Toll-free (800) 227-6963**; we will also have a link to click on. We will cover that in the next Newsletter. Unlike Florida, this Hotel prefers to see over time the rooms are booked to keep our numbers estimated in place. They start with 271-365 days, where they would like to see 10% of bookings done, and 181-270 days out, they would like to see 20% of the bookings done. Normally, people seem to wait till the last minute weeks out to book. We

need be aggressively using all Military Related Sites to get the word out about our Reunion. I would also encourage booking to begin in the next month.

**Hospitality Room:** Our group includes Breakfast Served in our Hospitality Room Only. Food from the hotel restaurant: Scrambled Eggs, Bacon, Sausage, (alternating days) Home Fries, Breakfast Pastries, Hot / Cold Cereal, Fresh Fruit, Juice, Coffie, Tea,

The Hotel has two restaurants, and we will be given a 20% Discount on all food should you use them, but you must tell them you are with Yosemite Reunion upfront.

#### **Amenities:**

Free Parking and Complementary WiFi in all Guest Rooms and Meeting Spaces and Support Equipment (Podiums, Mic, Flags, Special tables, etc.)

They will designate a special table at the main lobby for our guests to pick up name tags. We are allowed to have banners which they will hang / Yosemite Posters.

The Hotel will provide free transportation to and from the Airport. Our Reunion guests will call the Hotel, and they will send a small bus or vehicle to pick them up (usually a 15-minute wait).

We will be allowed to conduct our Raffle & Auction without any licenses/permits as a Military Group. Once again, this is an exception for our group.

We can have our own food (Pizza etc.), snacks, and drinks, including Alcoholic, in our Hospitality Room. Additionally, they have created a special package of Hourdorves they offer only to Military Groups that we will most likely consider for Wednesday afternoon in our Hospitality Room. It consists of International Cheese, and Cracker Display / Vegetable Crudité display that they will offer us for \$ 210 and not available to normal guests and priced very well. Will nicely support our Hospitality room Wednesday late afternoon say 4:00 PM. While I do prefer to purchase our snacks and food on our own, this does not even compare to their normal items. it is a really nice spread.
