Naval Academy Tour

The Naval Academy Tour will last approximately 2 hours, and we will then have lunch at the Drydock Restaurant at the Academy at about 11:30 am, before departing for the Hotel at approximately 12:30 pm.

Two Options are available: Option 1, a riding tour for \$55 or Option 2, a walking tour for \$36

- Option 1: GEM riding tour, a small electric vehicle like a minibus that holds a small number of people for a tour lasting just over 75 minutes. Departs at 10 am from the Visitors Center
- Option 2: Walking tour with a guide. about 90 minutes. Just over 1 mile.

Lunch for our group will be at the DRYDOCK Restaurant. Individuals select from their lunch menu and pay for their food. We will have our own area in the Restaurant and people to address our group. Pricing is off the charts inexpensive. See the Newsletter for examples.

Please note: Credit or Debit Cards are used while at the facility. They do not deal in cash, including the Gift Shop.

Maritime Museum Tour

Maritime Museum \$25.00 includes admission. You will tour the Museum on your own. If you finish ahead of the group, a small local seafood market (Wilds Country Seafood) that makes Fish and Chips and a few other dishes is right next to the Museum. I recommend trying it, I did. All fresh from the local waters.

Please note:

- Acceptable IDs for visitors accessing USNA through the Pedestrian Gate 1 Visitor Control Center include:
- REAL ID Compliant Driver's License or State ID card (look for the five-point gold star on the driver's license).

- U.S. Passport and U.S. Passport card. Foreign passports are not permitted for general access.
- Enhanced Driver's License (MI, MN, NY, VT, WA).
- Note: This does NOT affect access by credentialed personnel (CAC, DBIDS, Dependents, Retirees). Any Military ID is acceptable.
- Effective May 2025,) please note that as a result of the REAL ID Act, some state/territory IDs are not sufficient for access to the Academy. Please check the Current Status of States/Territories to see if your state or territory's ID is compliant with the REAL ID Act. Drivers' licenses and state IDs from states that aren't compliant must be accompanied by an acceptable second form of ID (SSN Card, Certified Copy of a Birth Certificate, U.S. Citizen ID Card, etc.).
